Red Devils 2011..

Experience the adrenalin rush of tandem skydiving for Maggie's with the world famous Red Devils!

On Tuesday 2nd August 2011, Maggie's Oxford and Maggie's Cheltenham are joining forces to host a unique, one-day event at the Red Devils HQ, Netheravon Airfield, Wiltshire. We are looking for 30 people to make an exhilarating tandem skydive whilst raising money for our centres.

This exciting day will involve an introduction to the Red Devils Team followed by a thorough training session on the ground. When you are fully briefed, and it is your turn to jump, you will board the aircraft with your Red Devils tandem instructor, who you will be attached to in readiness for your jump. The aircraft will take off and climb to 13,000 feet from which you will be able to see stunning aerial views from a unique perspective. At exit altitude you move to the door of the aircraft and at the count of 3, jump out into freefall. The next 45 seconds will be the most amazing of your life, before your instructor deploys the parachute at 6,000ft for the canopy ride to the ground. A deposit and minimum sponsorship is required.
